Faith Award is also rewarded to **Elsie** in Year 5 for supporting her parents whilst they have been unwell by helping around the home and looking after her younger siblings.

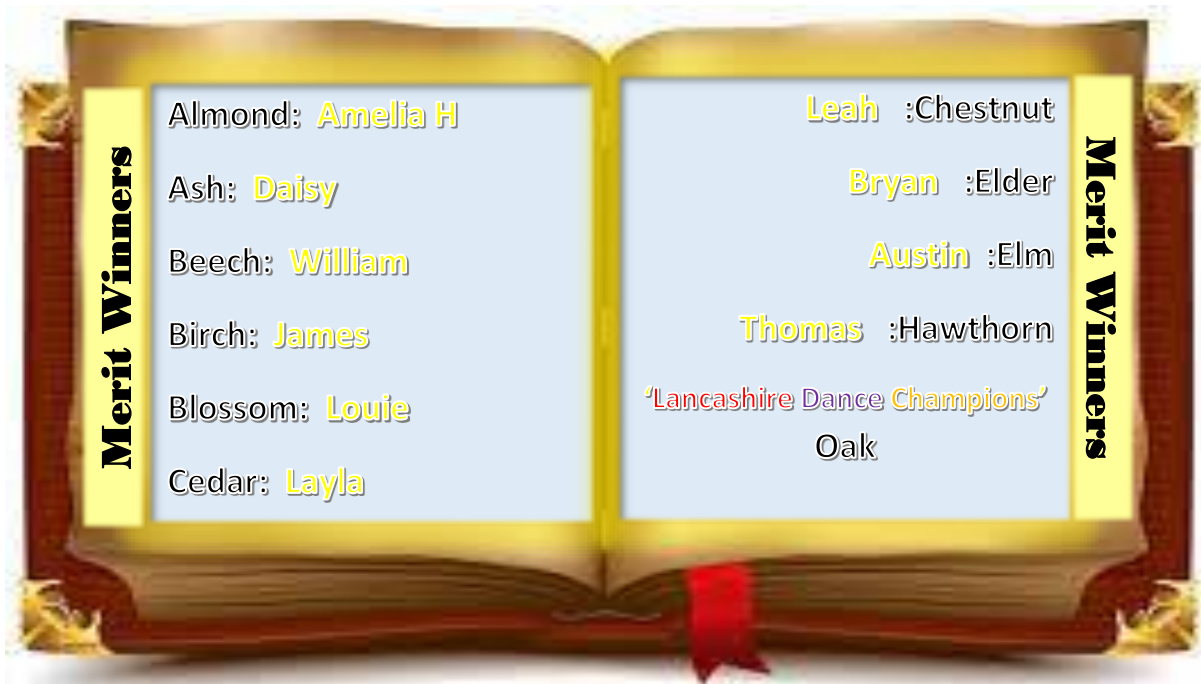
All the children have made us extremely proud as they have clearly demonstrated our Christian Values.

Every week one child from each class gets their name in the 'Golden Book' for excellent effort and hard work. This week, the children who received a merit certificate are:

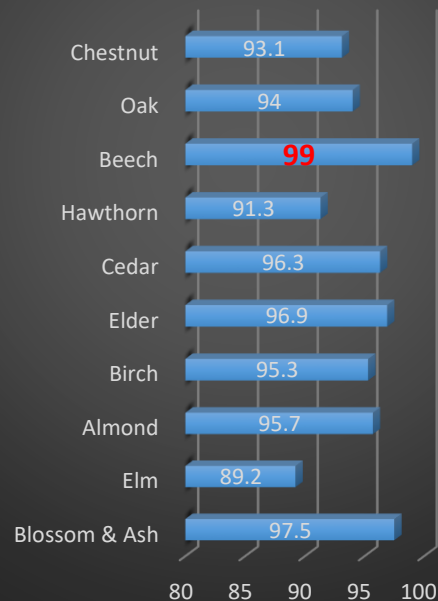

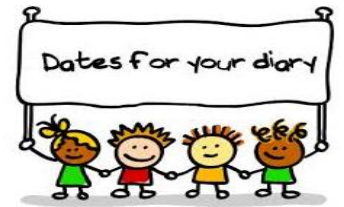
