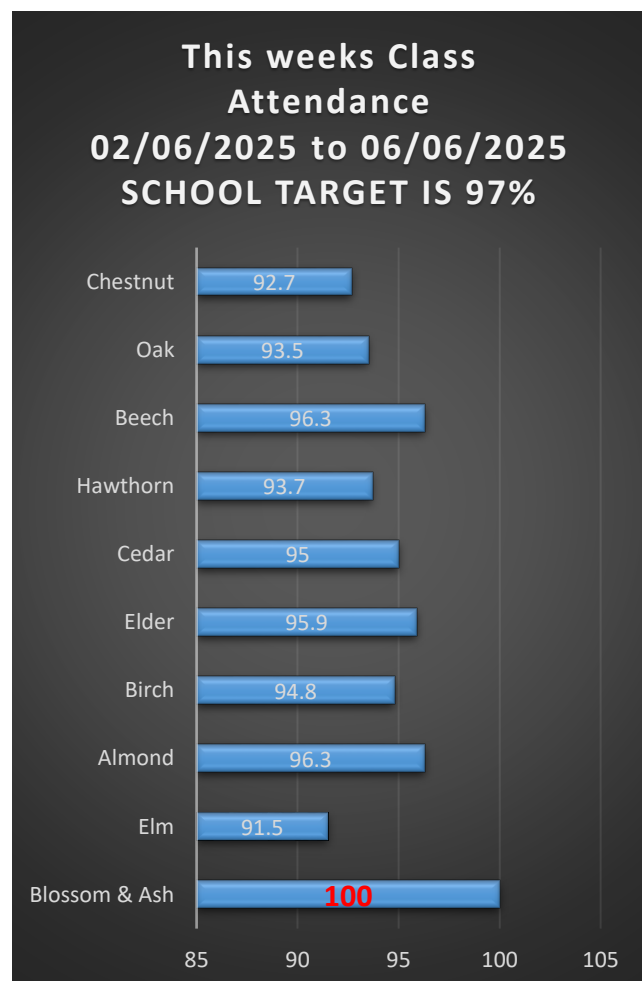
## Merit Winners

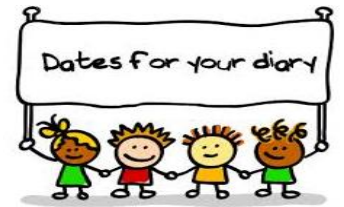
