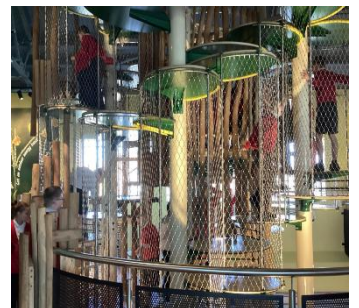

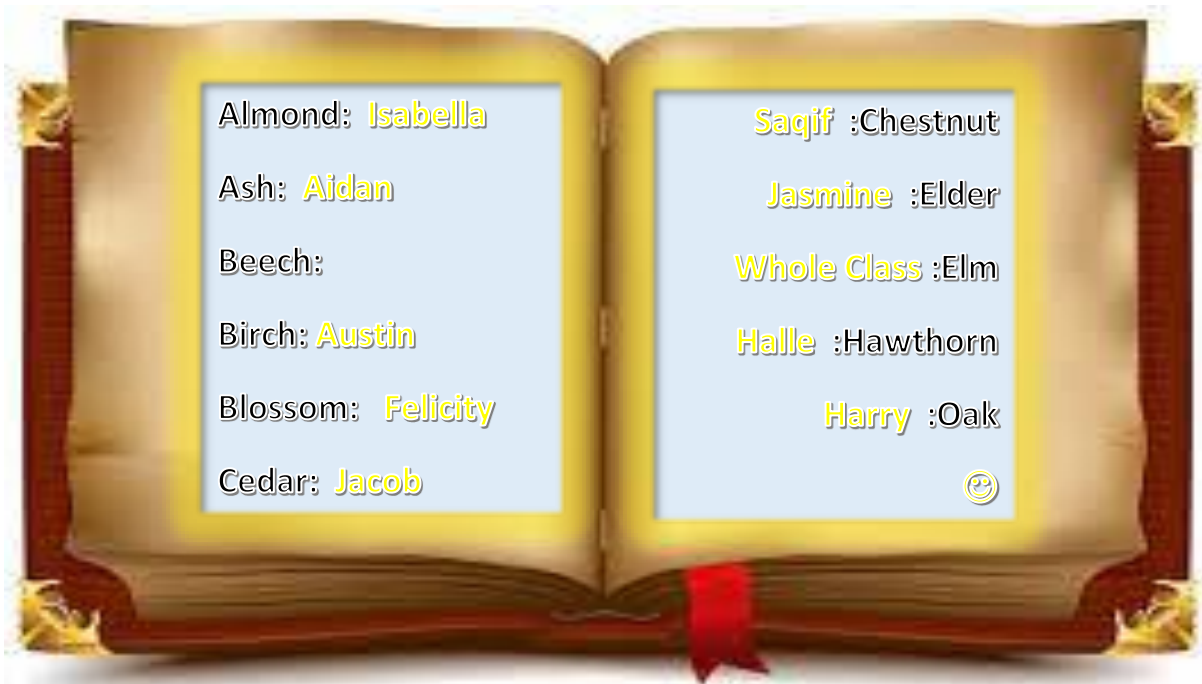

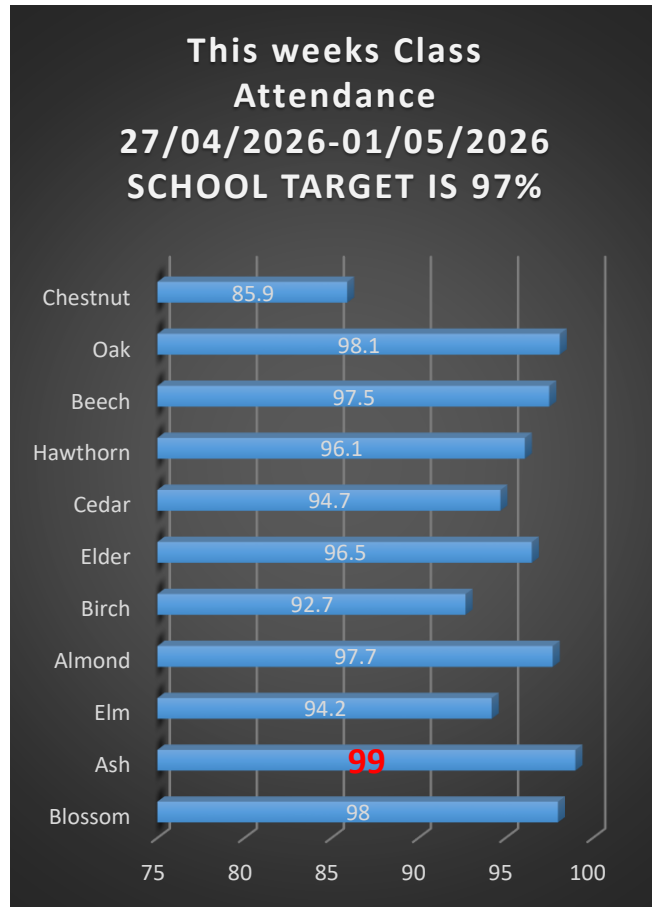
Merit Winners

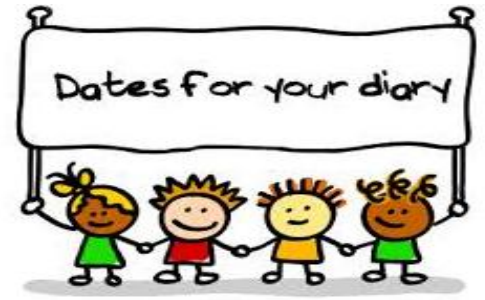
