Why do we need a Safeguarding Policy?

This policy explains how all adults help to keep us safe at school.

Our health, safety and wellbeing are very important, helping us to feel happy, supported and ready to learn.




The policy helps to protect children while they are in school and teaches us the skills and knowledge we need to stay safe both in school and in our everyday lives outside of school.



How are we kept safe in school?

- ✓ Our school grounds and building are securely locked. 
- ✓ Visitors must speak to the office before entering the school grounds and must sign in at the office and wear a visitors badge. 
- ✓ All staff wear a badge with their photograph and name on. 
- ✓ A register is taken in the morning and afternoon. 
- ✓ We have lots of staff that are First Aid trained and we can go to the Infant area if we are hurt. 
- ✓ We have a sensory room that we can go to with an adult to help us feel calm and safe. 
- ✓ We have playtime rules to help us feel safe. 
- ✓ Our school building and outdoor area are safe and looked after. 
- ✓ We have a lollipop person to help us keep safe when travelling to and from school. 

How do we know what to do in an emergency?

- ✓ We know what to do when there is a fire and practice fire drills. 
- ✓ Our teachers know what each sound of our alarm system means. 
- ✓ We listen carefully to our teachers and follow instructions. 
- ✓ We can ask any adult in school for help.
