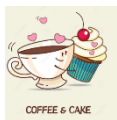


Bake Off

A special thank you to all our parents and carers who popped in to have coffee and cake. It was lovely to see you all and we look forward to the next one.

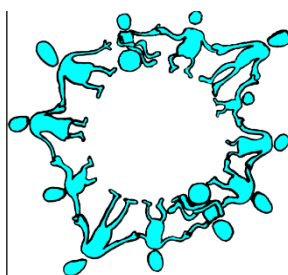

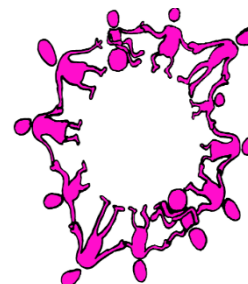
Fingers crossed the weather starts to improve, so that on Thursday we can enjoy our obstacle course. Please ensure that your child comes to school dressed in their PE kit.

Faith Award

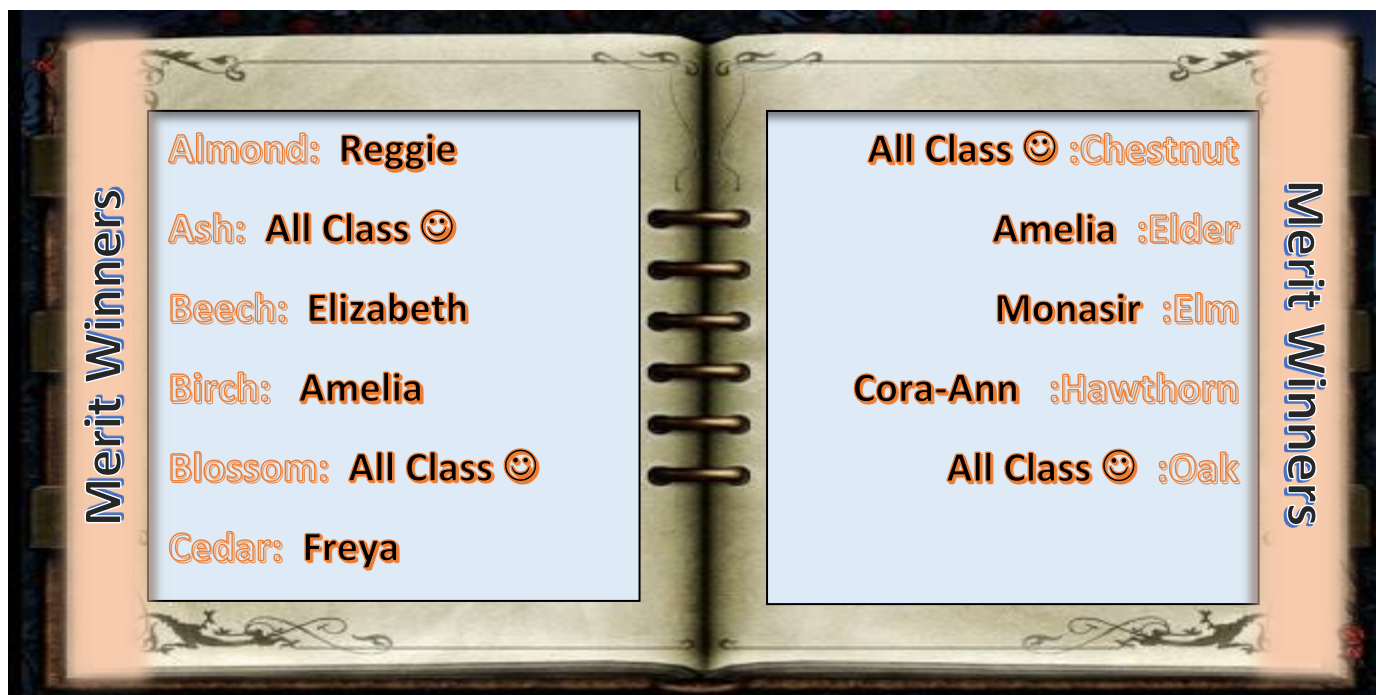

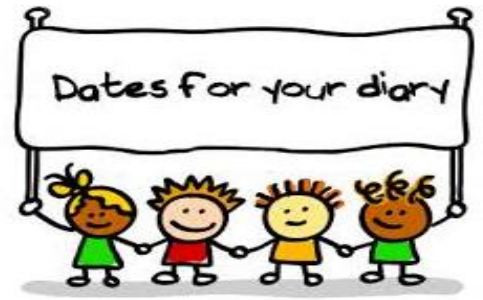
