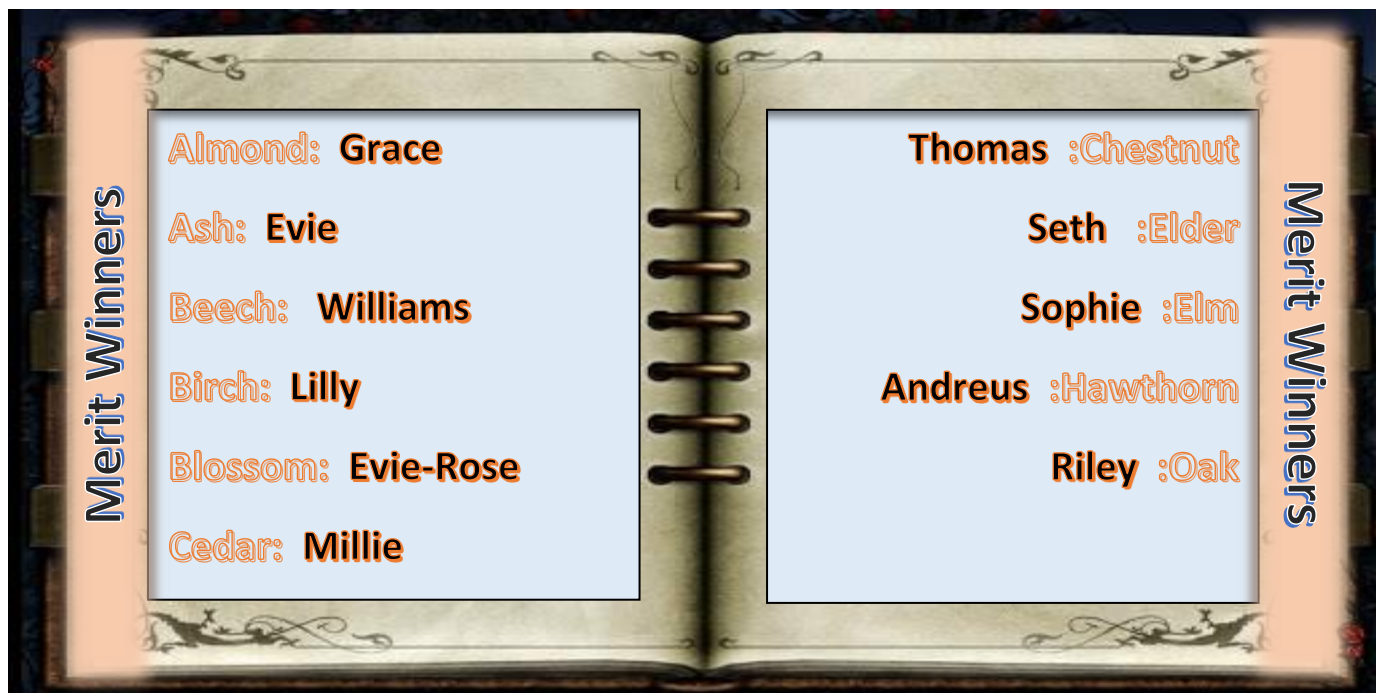
### Battery Hunt
