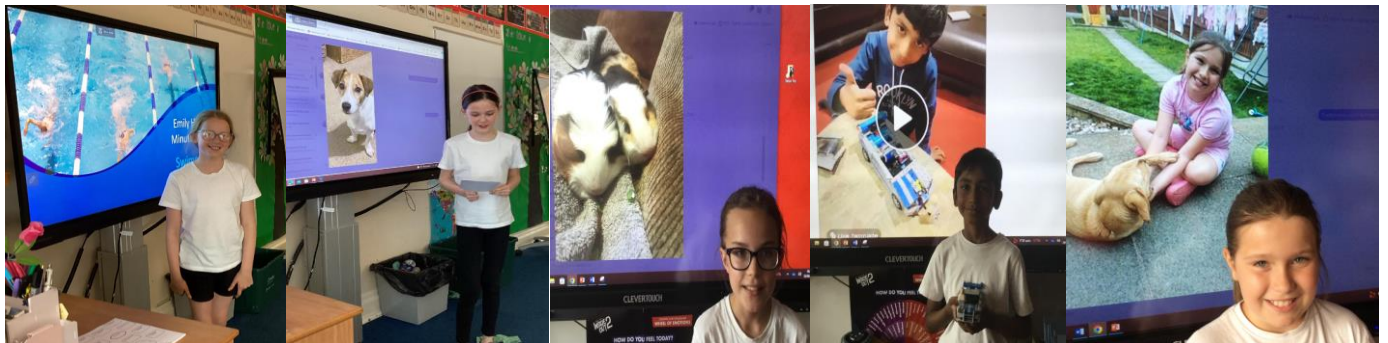
PGL

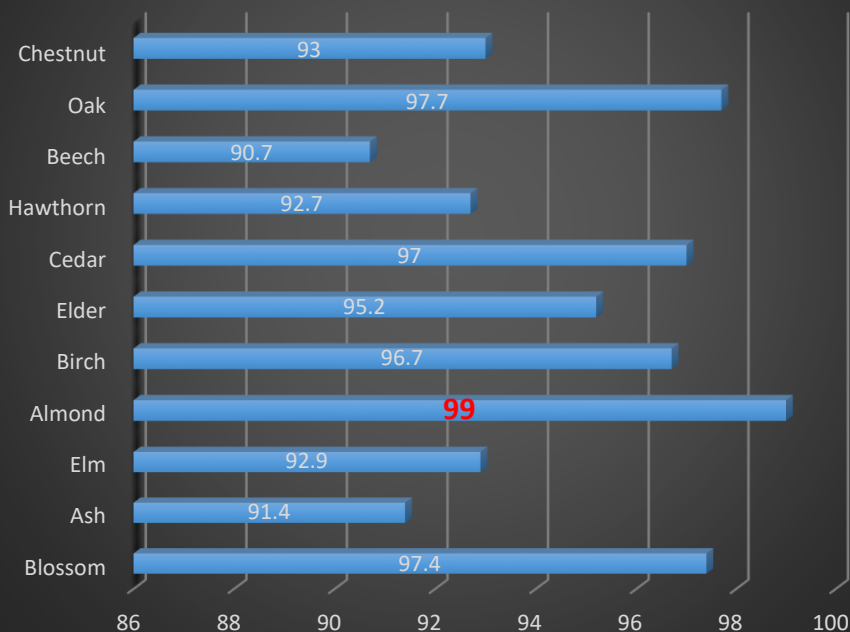

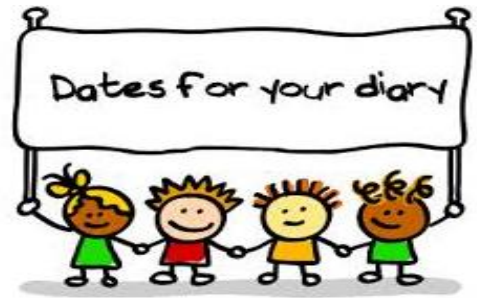
