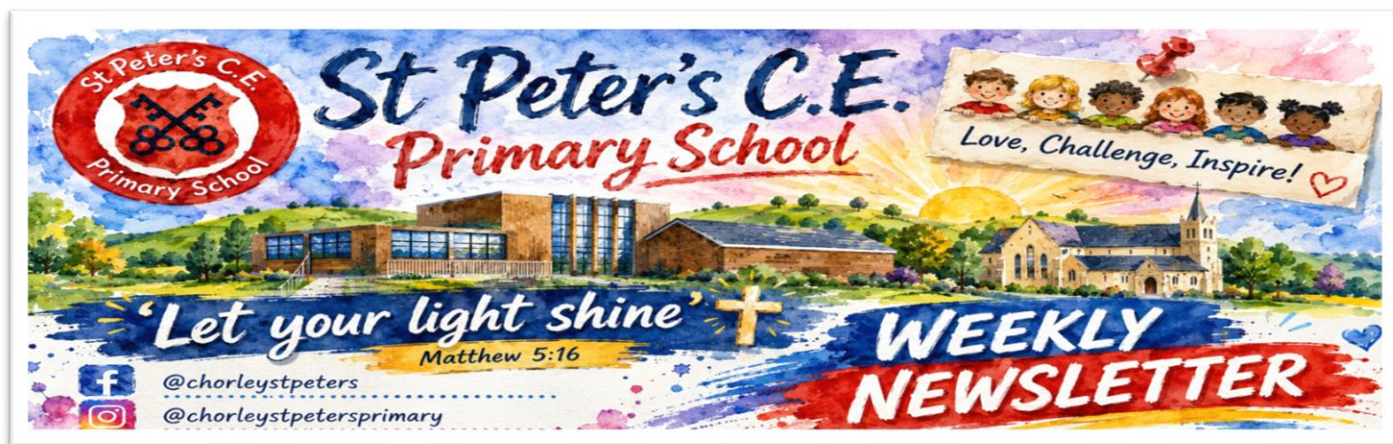




Friday 18th September 2026

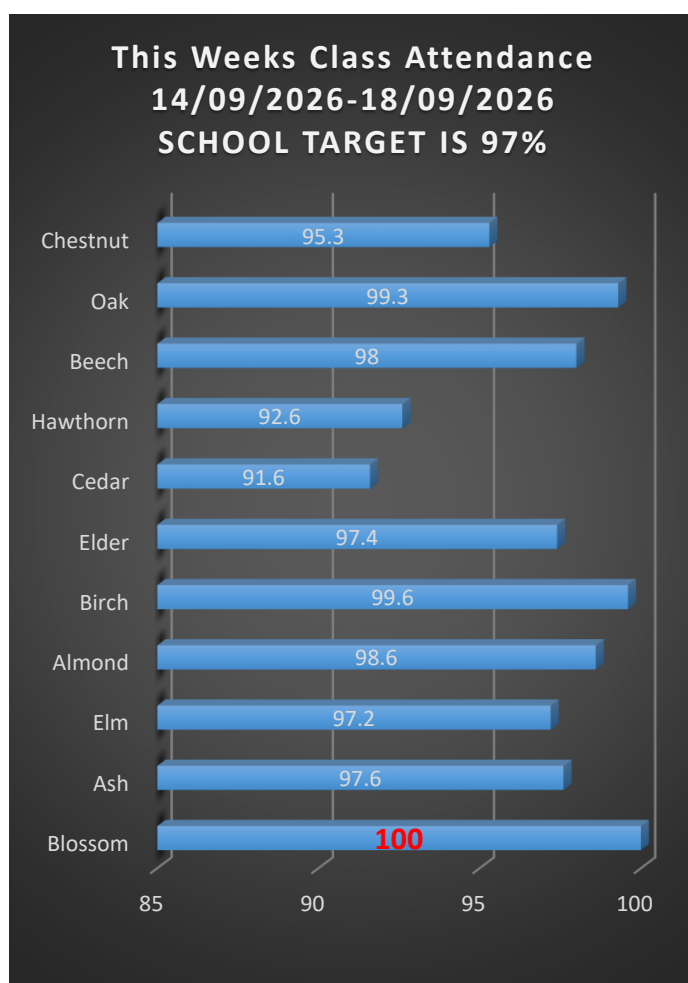
Merit Winners

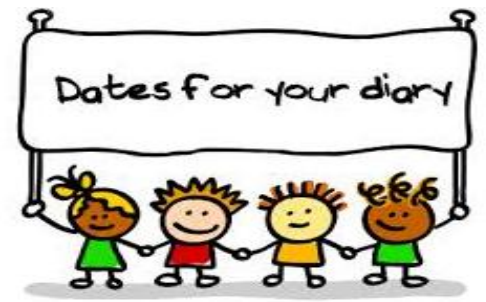

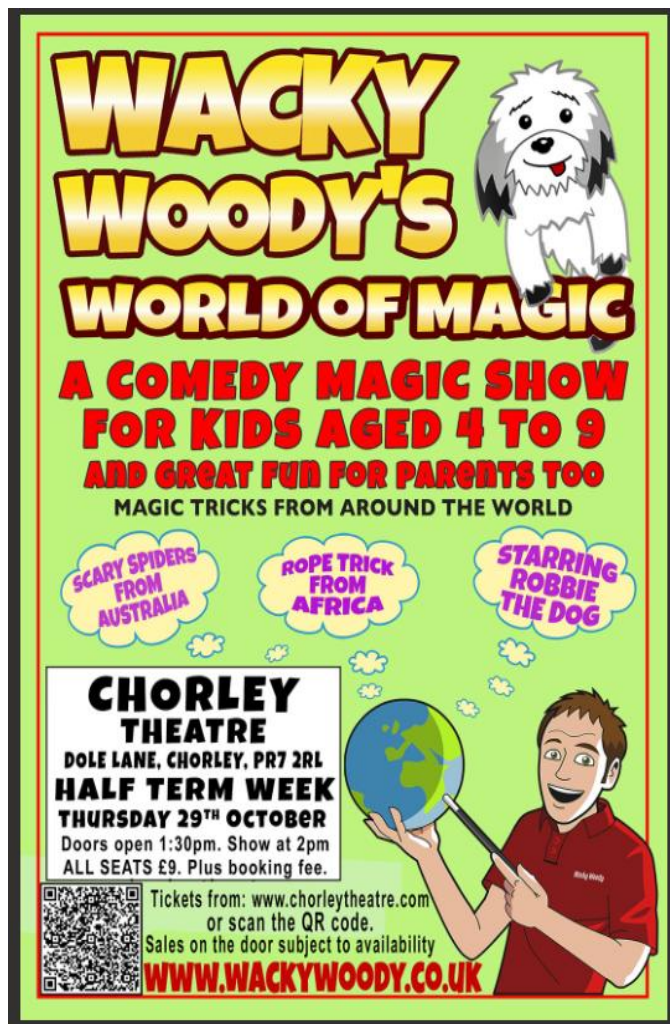

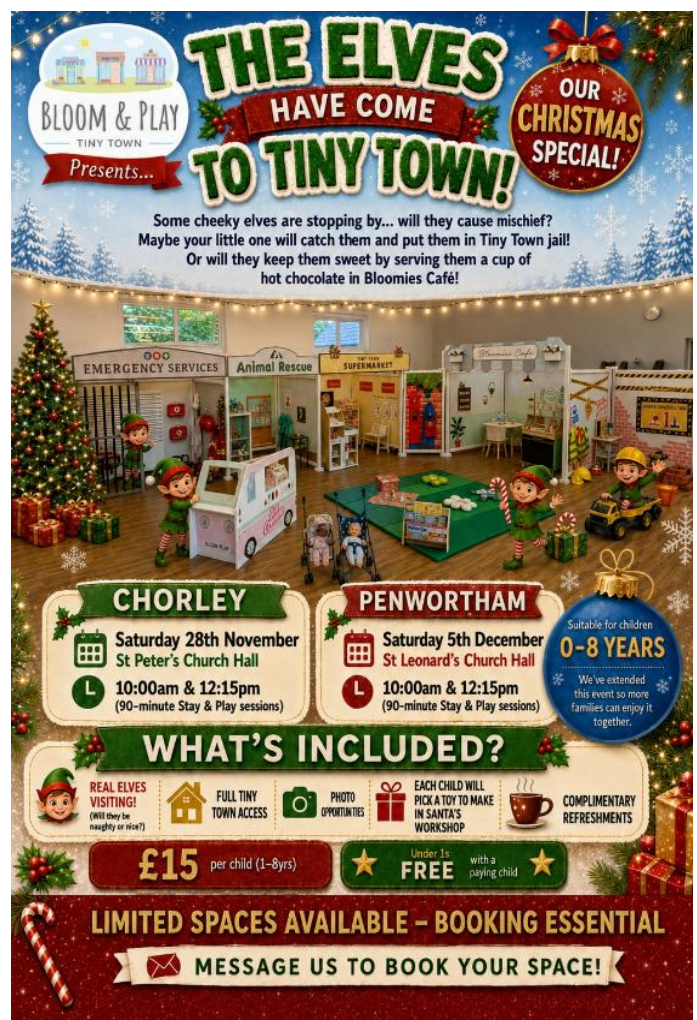
