



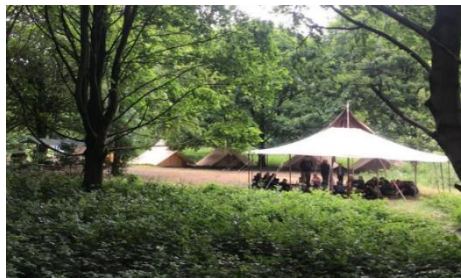

On Thursday we were joined by Freddie Fit in school which the children all thoroughly enjoyed.

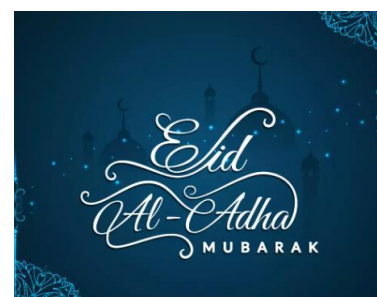


Faith Trail

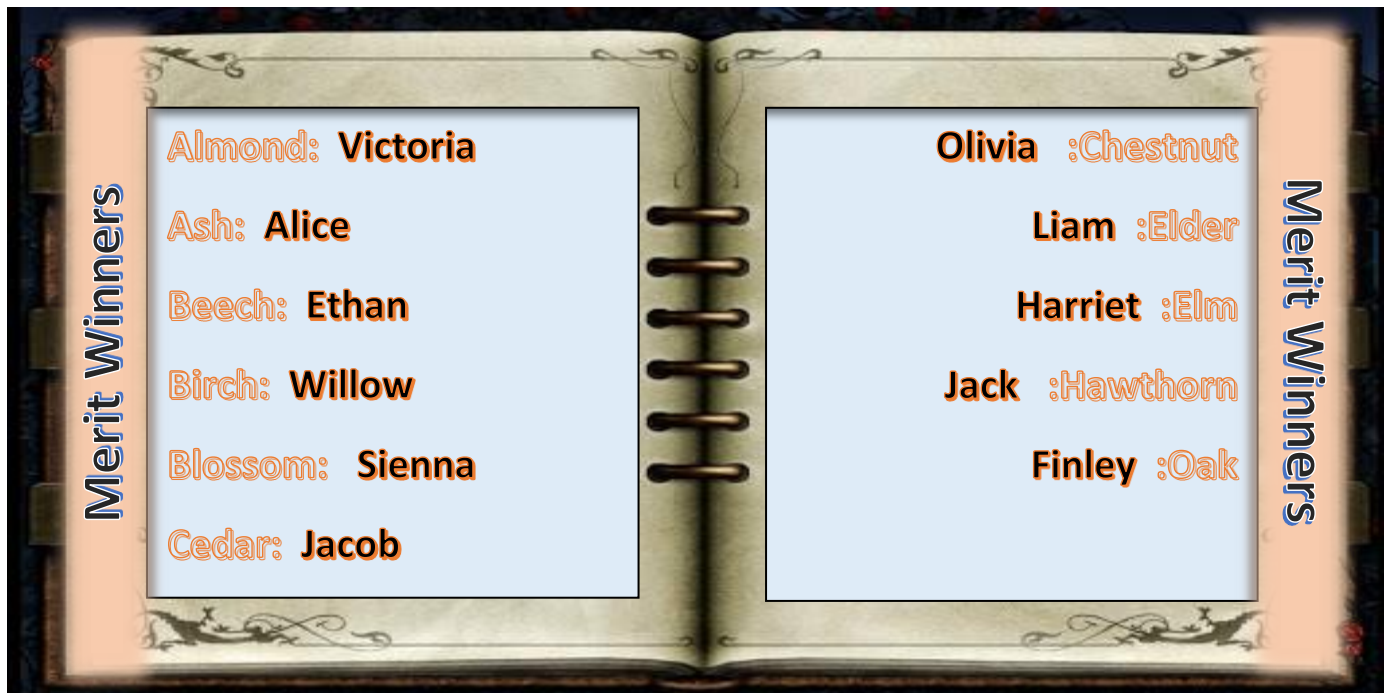
Battery Hunt

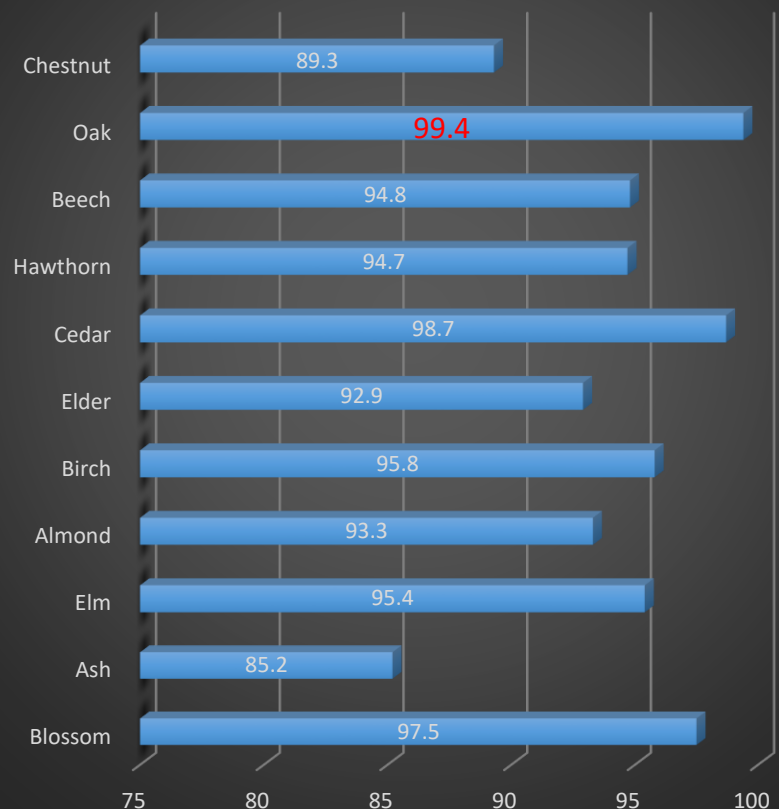

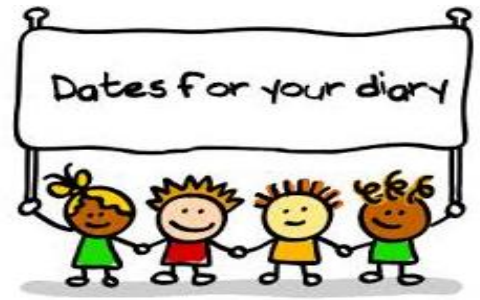
