Heart month



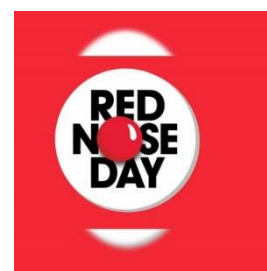

From selling Heart Foundation items in school and collecting donations we raised an incredible £181.13. A huge thank you to all our families for supporting this cause.

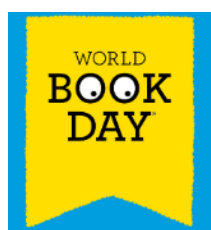
Red Nose Day

Every week one child from each class gets their name in the 'Golden Book' for excellent effort and hard work. This week, the children who received a merit certificate are:



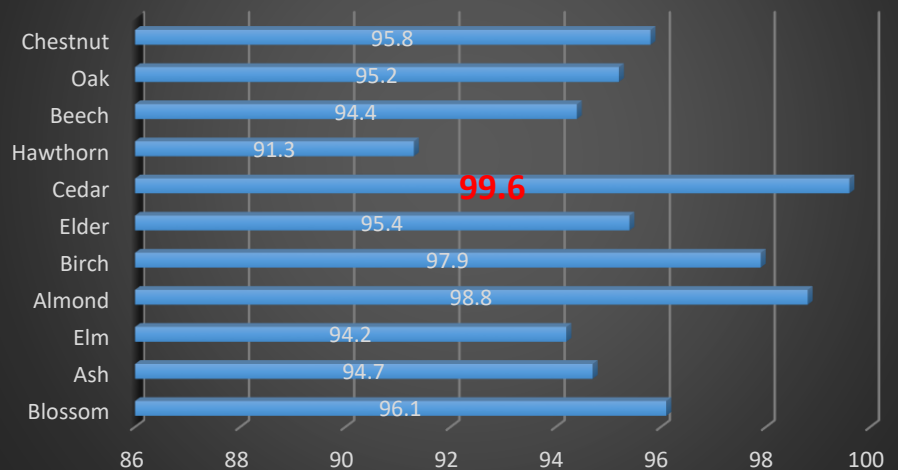

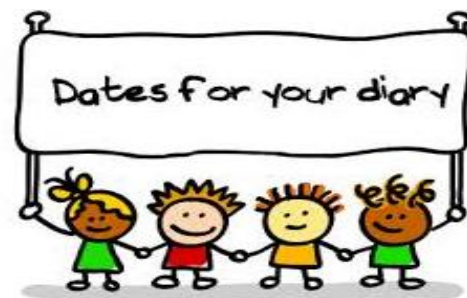
