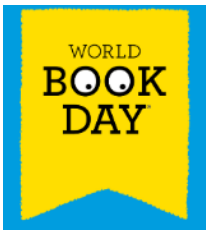
Red Nose Day

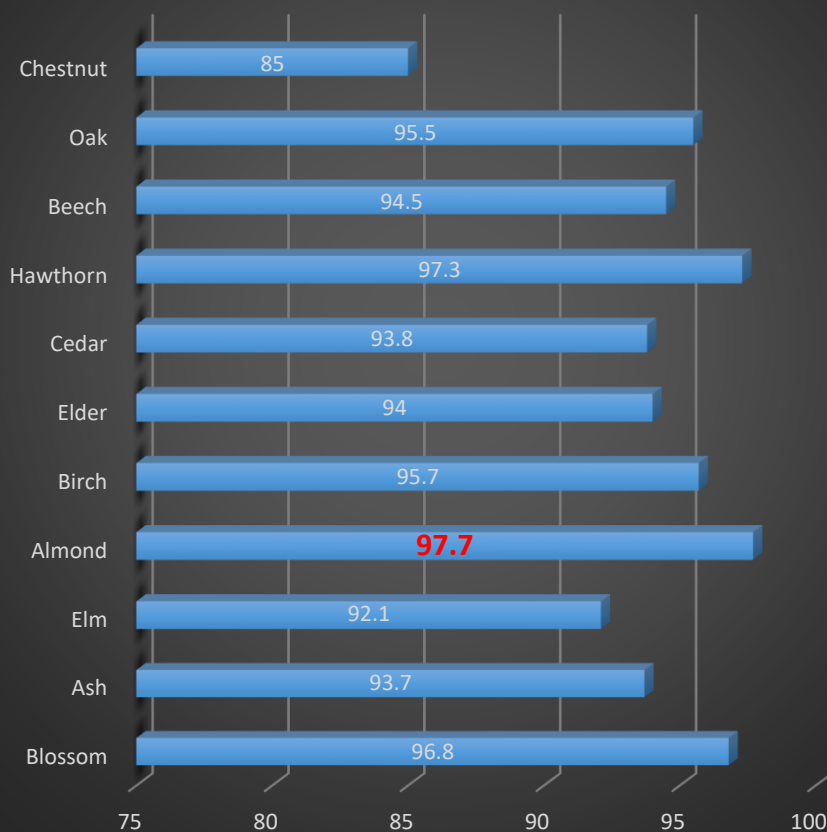

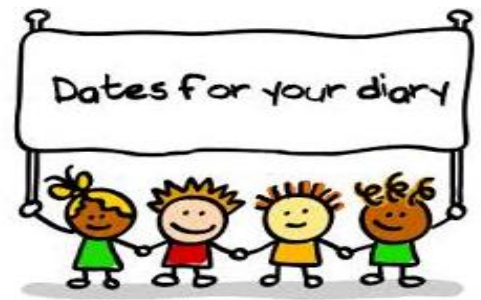
