The teams had a great day representing school in the four events the Ks1 team finished 9th out of 16 school. Dexter came first overall in the boys.

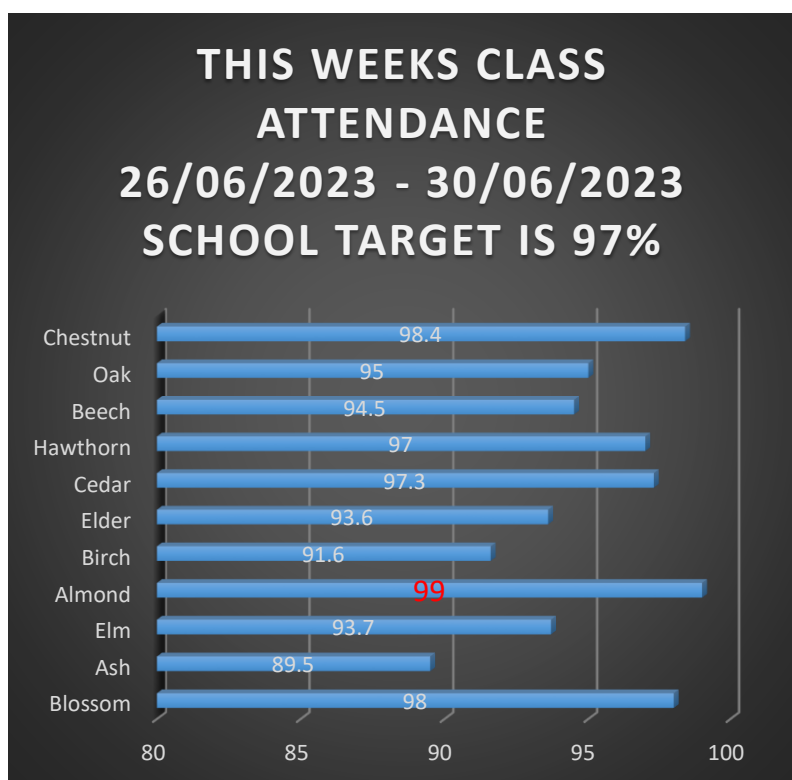
The KS2 team finished 11th out of 20 schools.

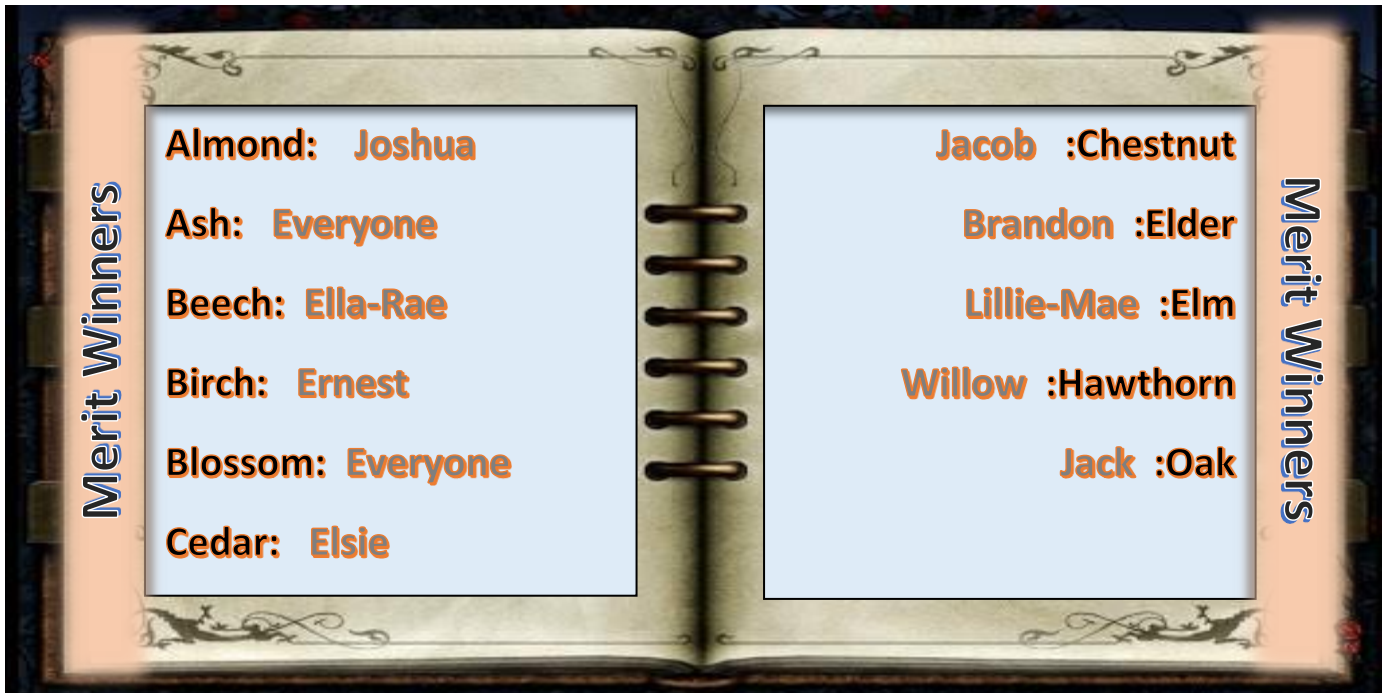

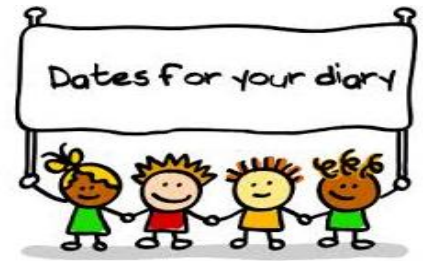
