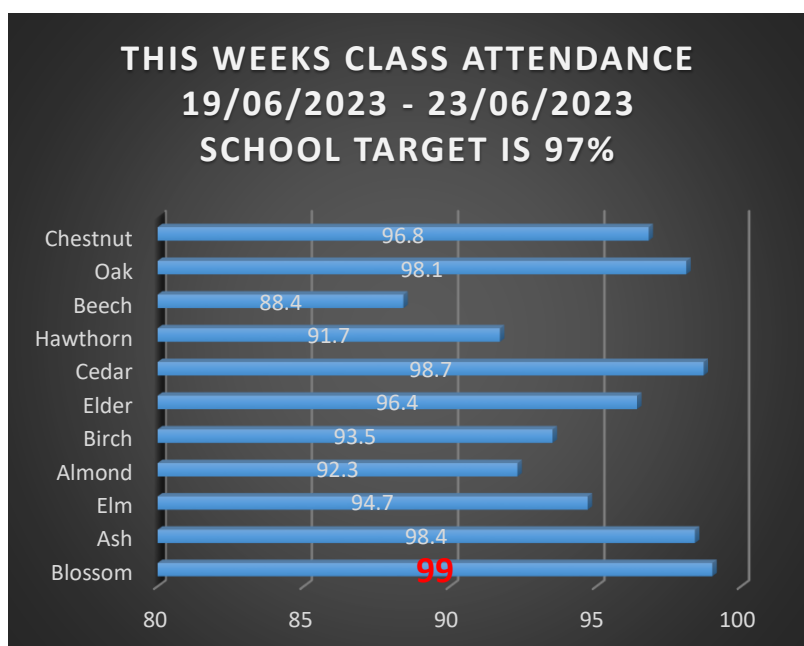
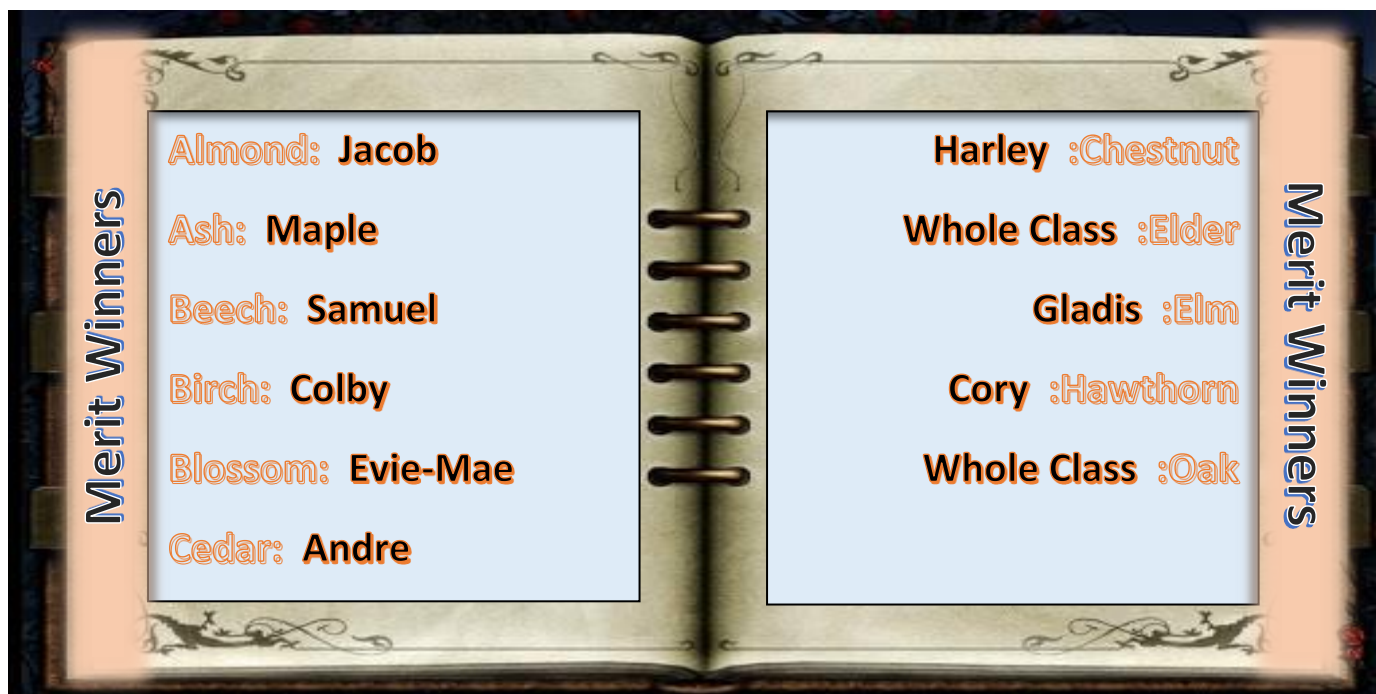
OAK CLASS:

John 14:27

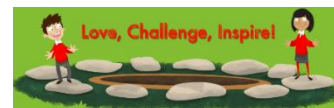

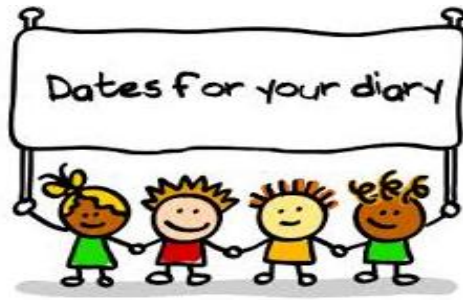
