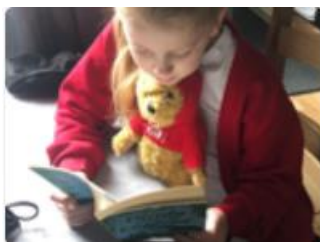
HAWTHORN CLASS:

Reflection Time

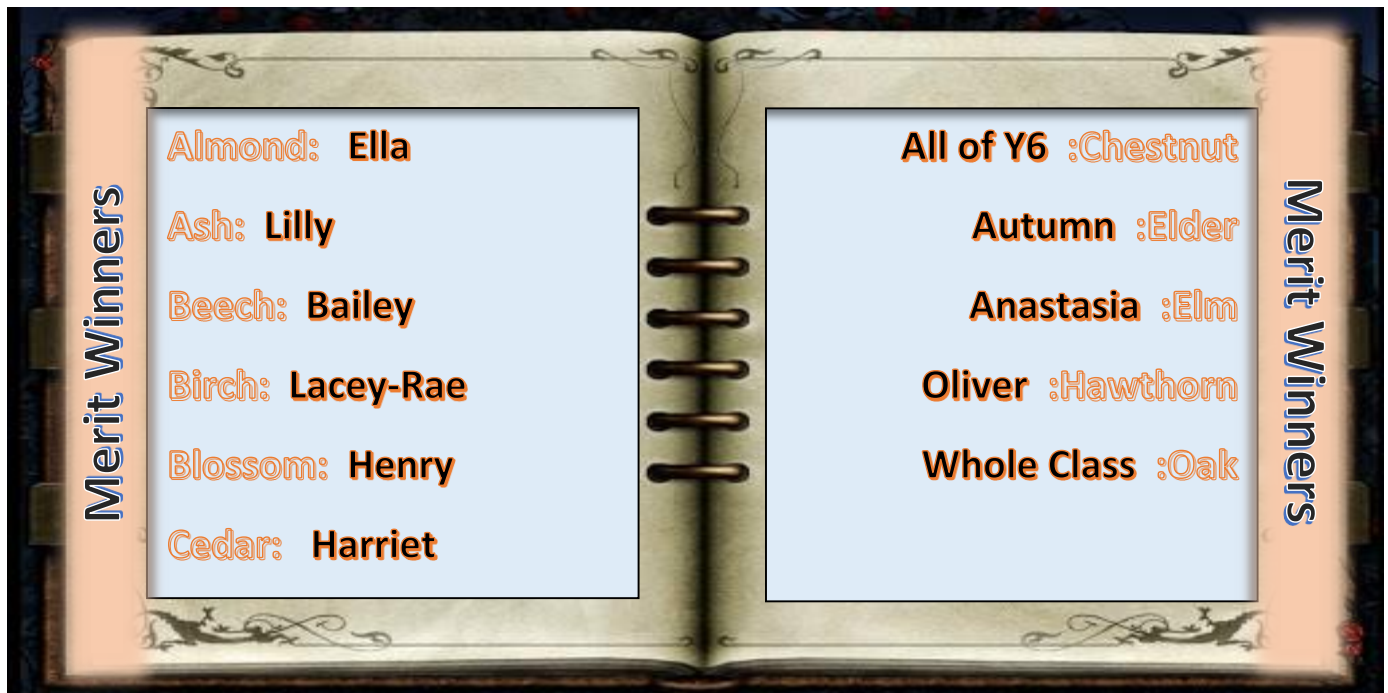

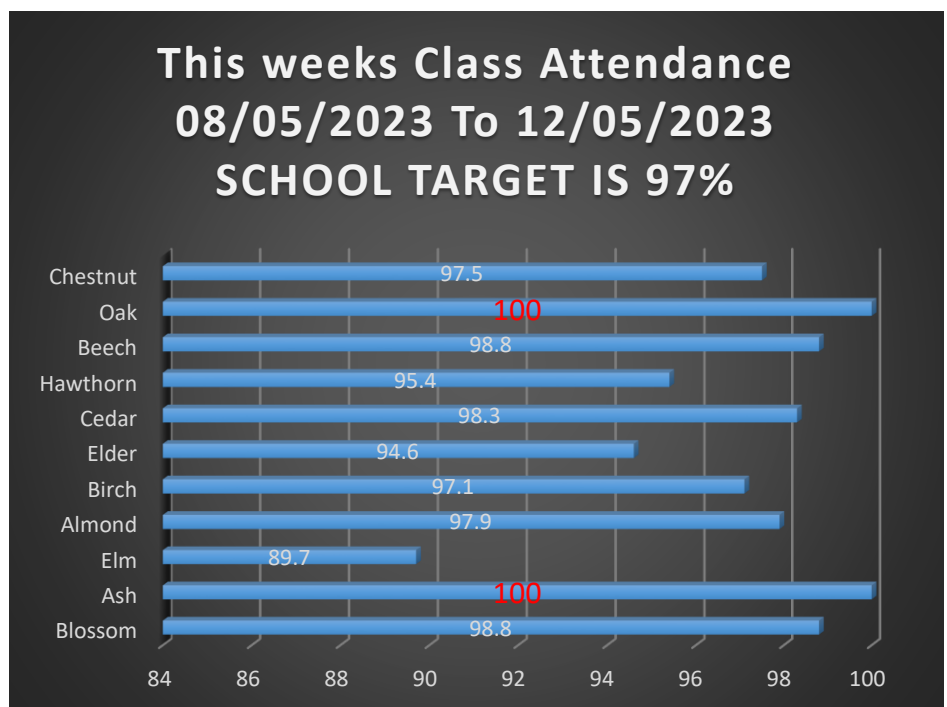

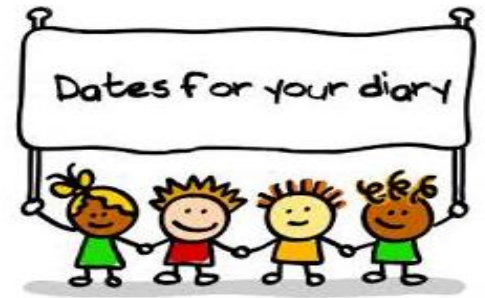
