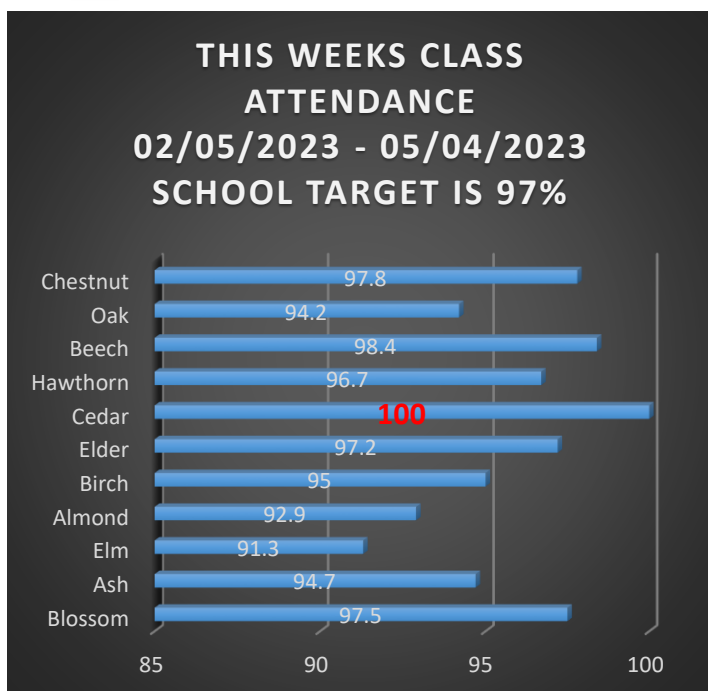
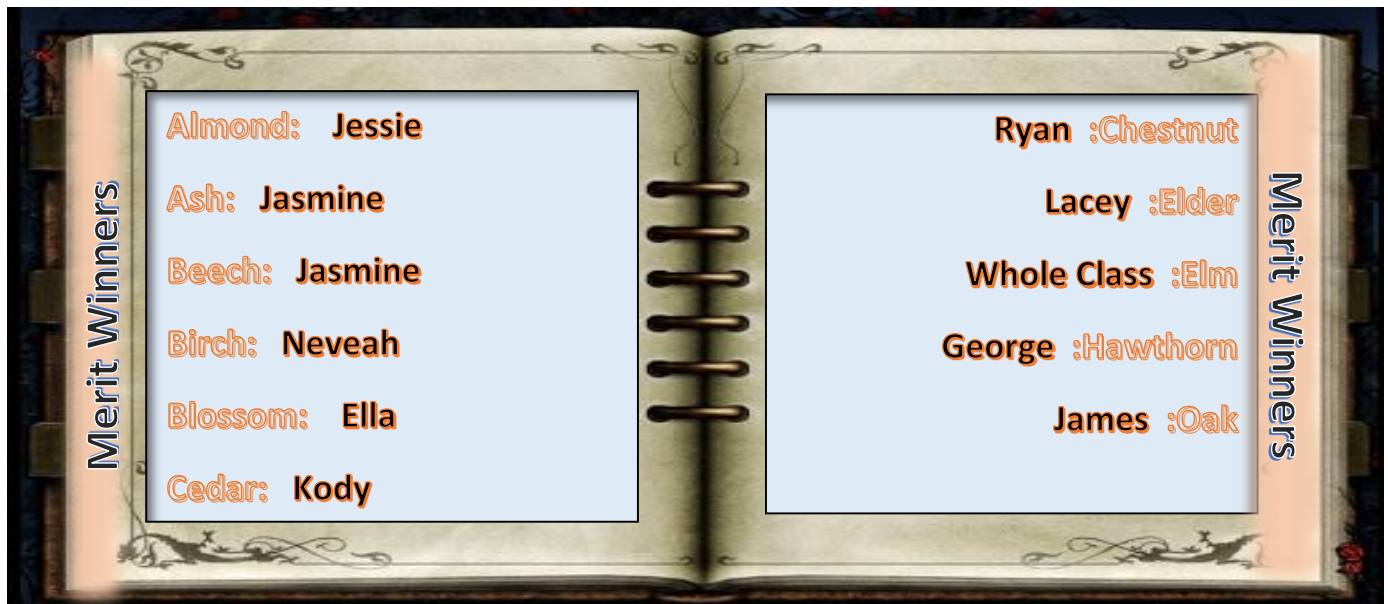
### Elder Class:

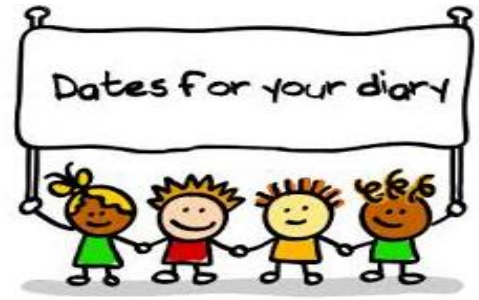
