Cultural:

On Monday, Year 5 and 6 were visited by CSSP, who set us a task. The Culture project this year is focussing on the green value. We sat through a session where we spoke about the issues around carbon footprints, climate change and how it impacts our Earth. We also spoke about how we could change our day-to-day routines in order to help our planet and this allowed our children to think about creative ideas into what can be done to help our Sport industry. Nike are currently trying to develop a 'recycled' training shoe, so following this discussion, Year 5 were set the task of designing one for them. Year 6 were set a task of writing a pledge about how they can help our planet in our fight against climate change.

Safer Internet Day:

To celebrate Safer Internet Day, we discussed all the amazing things that we can do using the internet. We discussed what we liked to do. We then spoke about although it is incredible, the internet isn't perfect and sometimes people use it in ways that are unkind and safe. We wrote a list of who we can talk to if we see something that upsets or worries us. We know the more we talk about things we see and do online, the easier it is for us all to support each other. It also means if something ever does go wrong, it's even easier to find someone to help.



We then played a game, if the children landed on a "help" square, they had to read a scenario and decide what question they would need to ask for help.

Church Worship:

On Wednesday, Beech class visited St Peter's Church to take part in the Eucharist Service. We enjoyed listening to Reverend Rebecca's sermon, which got us thinking about how salt and light are similar, both adding flavour to our lives and helping us in times of need. Year 5 also led the congregation in singing the hymn 'Here I am, Lord' and were each given a blessing by Reverend Rebecca during the service.



Indoor Athletics FINAL!

Yesterday our Year 5/6 team completed in the Chorley Indoor Athletics Final! We were competing against 9 other schools. Our children were so well behaved and performed amazingly well. We managed to place 6 on the day which puts us 6th best out of 37 primary schools in Chorley! What an amazing result! We couldn't be prouder of our St Peter's children!

Chester Zoo

Our Key Stage One children had a fantastic trip to Chester Zoo yesterday. The children had a wonderful time and represented our school brilliantly. Luke 19: 1

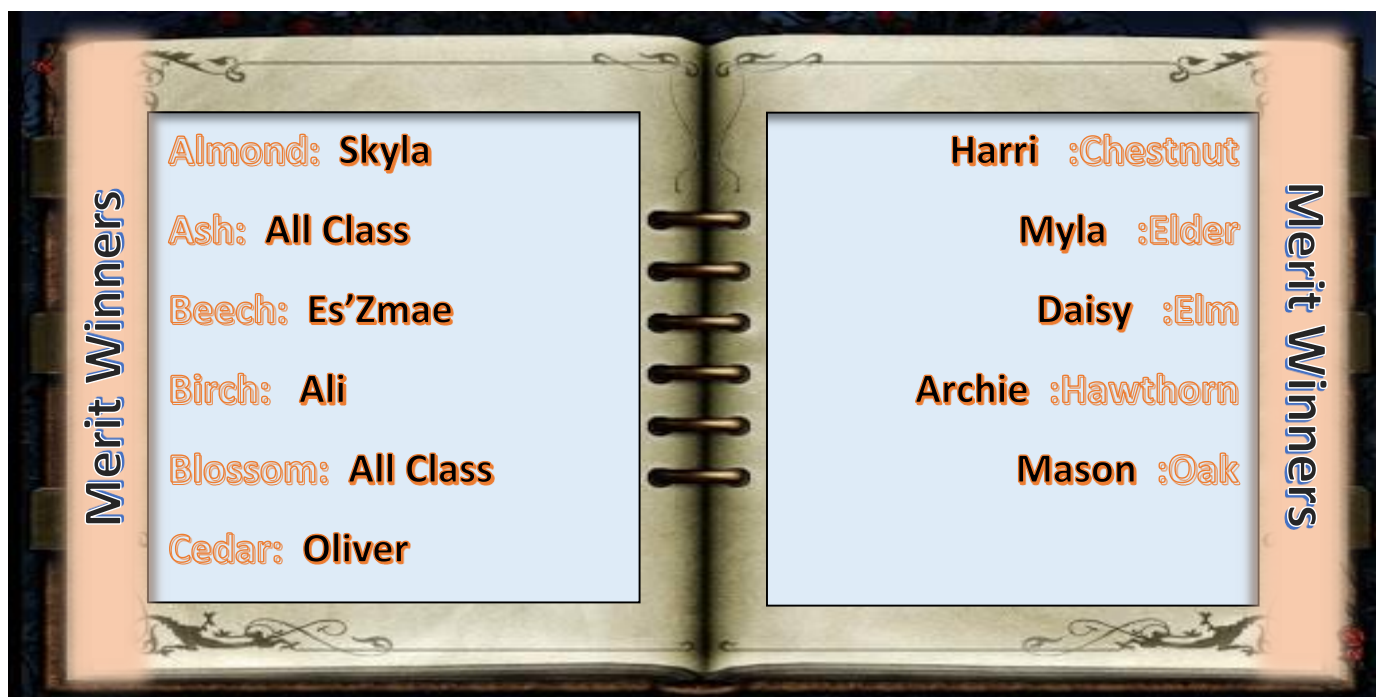
Faith Award:

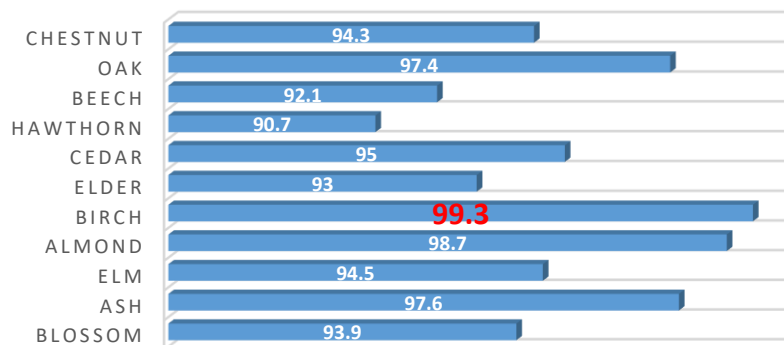

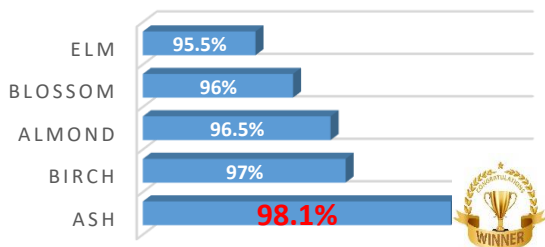


THIS WEEKS CLASS ATTENDANCE 06/02/23 TO 10/02/2023 SCHOOL TARGET IS 97%

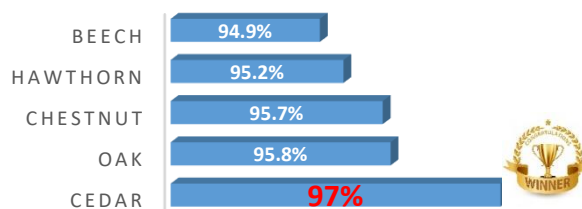


CLASS TROPHY WINNERS

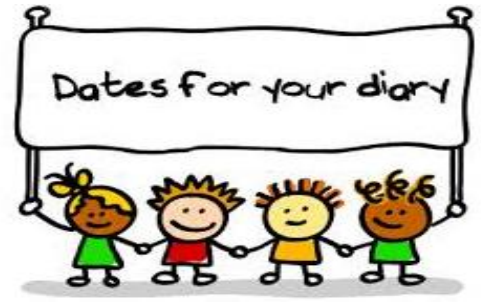
