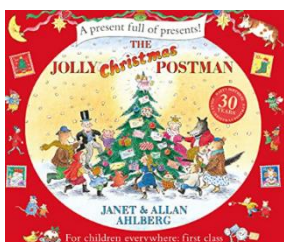


Year 2 Nativity with Year 1 Choir

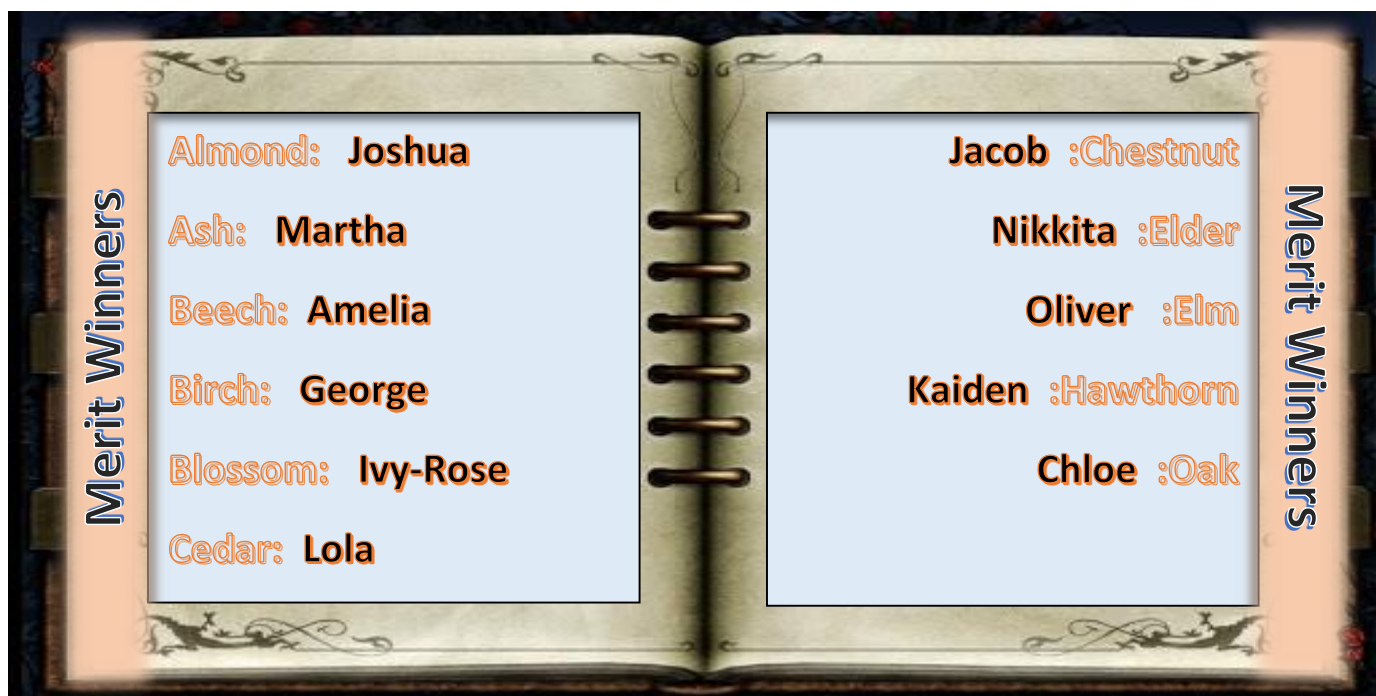
Reflection Time

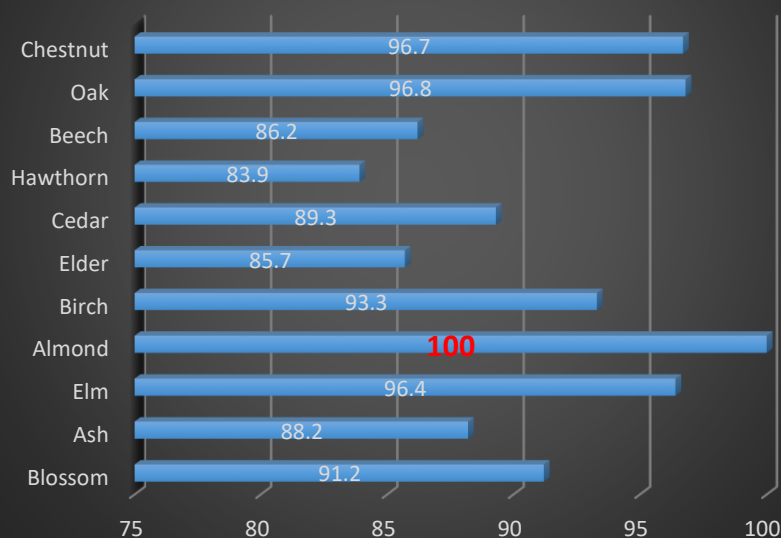

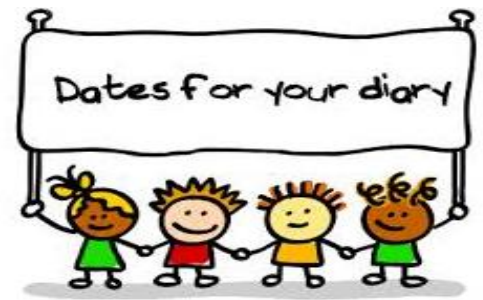
