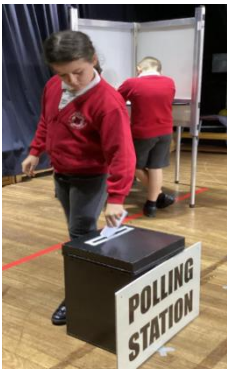

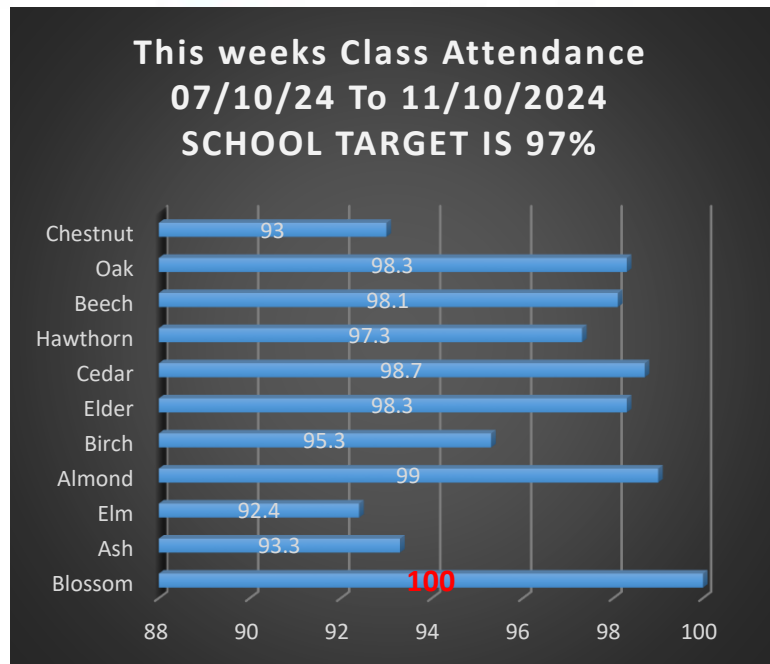
Reflection Time

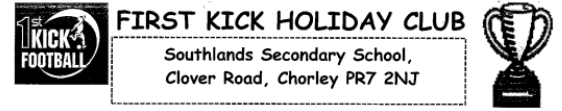
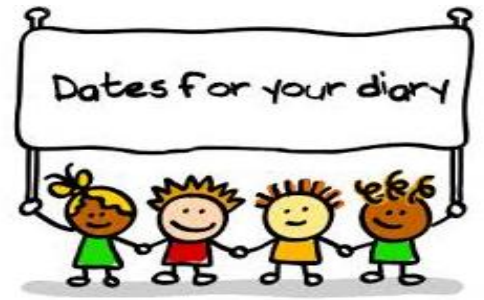
